Directions to the Skills Centre

The Youth Skill Centre is located at Komarock Location , next to Mbiiani Primary school off Nairobi - Kangundo road 50 kilometers East of Nairobi.

From CBD one goes through Jogoo Road, Donholm roundabout then join Kangundo Road from outer ring road at the Caltex junction. Proceed on Kangundo Road to Njiru market, Ruai Market, Kamulu market, cross the Athi River Bridge; go past Joska Market, then to Malaa market at KBC.

In Malaa Market opposite the road to KBC (VOK) media masts on the hill is a rough earth road down the Valley past the large eucalyptus farm. Precisely 3.2 kilometers from the Malaa Market is the Skills Centre. Sign posts will be put up at the road from Malaa to the site. KARIBU
